Language is all around us! Through these simple and fun activities, you will improve your reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills — all while enjoying your holidays. Parents are encouraged to participate and support their children in exploring, imagining, and expressing themselves.

Read with Joy! (Reading Skill)

Objective: Build vocabulary, comprehension, and a love for books.

Activity:

- Read any 2 English storybooks from the given link or the story books at your home.

- For each book, draw your favourite part and write 3–4 sentences about it.
Example: "I liked the monkey who jumped on the bed."

2. My Word Garden (Writing Skill)

Objective: Vocabulary building through imagination and drawing.

Activity:

- Choose one letter of the alphabet every day for 10 days.
- Draw 2–3 things that begin with that letter and write their names.
- Example: For "B" – Ball, Banana, Butterfly.



- Make it colorful and keep it in a scrapbook or notebook.

3. Listen & Tell (Listening + Speaking Skill)

Objective: Improve listening comprehension and oral expression. Activity:

- Listen to 3 English audio stories or rhymes (from the given links)

- Draw a picture of your favourite character from the story.

4. Fun with Family Talks (Speaking Skill)

Objective: Build confidence in speaking in

English. **Activity:**

- Every alternate day, have a small English talk with a family member.
- Topics can be: My Toy, My Pet, My Favorite Food, My Best Friend. (MY toy is a car. It is red and fast. I play with it every day.)
- Record or write 2–3 sentences you said in your scrapbook.
- Paste a picture of one such family talk.

5. Alphabet Hunt Game

Objective: Integrate reading and observation.

Activity:

- Find objects around your home that begin with each letter of the alphabet (A–Z).
- Make a chart/poster with drawings or photos.
- Example: A – Apple, B – Bag, C – Cup, D – Door...

6. English Art-Integration Corner (Fun

Task) Objective: Express creativity using

English words. **Activity:**

- Create a “Words Around Me” collage using cut-out words from newspapers/magazines.
- Paste them under headings like: Food Words, Action Words, Nature Words, Animal Words.

"शब्दों की दुनिया – मजेदार भाषा की यात्रा!"

छात्रों और अभिभावकों के लिए निर्देश:

प्यारे बच्चों,
भाषा हमारे चारों ओर है। इन सरल और मजेदार गतिविधियों से आप पढ़ने, लिखने, सुनने और बोलने की कला को और बेहतर बनाएँगे। अभिभावकों से अनुरोध है कि वे बच्चों के साथ मिलकर इन्हें आनंदपूर्वक पूरा करें।

1. आनंद से पढ़ें! (पढ़ने का कौशल)

उद्देश्य: शब्दावली बढ़ाना, समझ विकसित करना, पुस्तकों से प्रेम बढ़ाना।

गतिविधि:

घर में मौजूद हिंदी की किसी भी 2 कहानी की किताबें पढ़ें या दिए गए लिंक से देखें।

हर कहानी से अपना पसंदीदा हिस्सा बनाएँ (चित्र) और 3-4 वाक्य लिखें।

उदाहरण:

2. मेरा शब्द बाग (लिखने का कौशल)

उद्देश्य: नई शब्दावली को चित्रों और कल्पना के माध्यम से सीखना।

गतिविधि:

10 दिनों तक हर दिन स्वर की एक मात्रा चुनें।

उस मात्रा से शुरू होने वाली 2-3 चीजें बनाएँ और उनके नाम लिखें।

उदाहरण: " आ की मात्रा बादल, तारा, माला, इ की मात्रा किसान, गिटार.....

इसे रंगीन बनाकर स्क्रेपबुक में सजाएँ।

3. सुनो और सुनाओ (सुनने + बोलने का कौशल)

उद्देश्य: सुनने की समझ और मौखिक अभिव्यक्ति को बेहतर बनाना।

गतिविधि:



नीचे दिए गए लिंक से 3 हिंदी कहानियाँ या कविताएँ सुनें।

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उसके बाद परिवार के सदस्य को अपनी भाषा में कहानी सुनाएँ।

7 जुलाई को कक्षा में बोलने के लिए तैयारी करें।

अपनी पसंदीदा कहानी के पात्र का चित्र बनाएँ।

4. परिवार संग बात-मुलाकात (बोलने का कौशल)

उद्देश्य: आत्मविश्वास के साथ अंग्रेज़ी बोलना सीखना।

गतिविधि:

हर दूसरे दिन किसी एक विषय पर परिवार के किसी सदस्य से थोड़ी सी हिंदी में बातचीत करें।

विषय उदाहरण: मेरी मां, मेरा पसंदीदा खिलौना, मेरा देश

उदाहरण वाक्य: मेरी मां दुनिया की सबसे अच्छी मां है। वह मुझे बहुत प्यार करती है।

बातचीत को लिखें या रिकॉर्ड करें और एक चित्र चिपकाएँ।

5. वर्णमाला खोज खेल (Alphabet Hunt)

उद्देश्य: पढ़ाई और अवलोकन को जोड़ना।

गतिविधि:

घर के आस-पास से अ से ज तक की वस्तुएँ ढूँढें जो हर शब्द से शुरू होती हों।

चित्र बनाकर या फोटो लेकर एक चार्ट तैयार करें।

उदाहरण: अ- अलमारी, अ आम, इ इमारत.....

Math is all around us! Through these simple and fun activities, you'll improve your math skills and build confidence in numbers. Enjoy exploring and learning with "Fun with Numbers"!

Fun with Numbers

1. Counting Fun

Objective: Practice counting and observation. What to do:

- Count the number of toys/pencils/books in your bag.
- Draw the objects and write the number with their number

name. Example:

- I have 5 pencils in my bag.
- Drawing: 5 pencils with the number "5" written below and its number name 'Five'.

2. Shape Scavenger Hunt



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Objective: Identify and recognize shapes.

What to do:

- Find objects at home that match different shapes (e.g., circle, square, triangle).
- Draw the shapes and write the object's name.
- Examples:
 - Circle: plate, coin, ball

Number Line Fun:

Objective: Understand number sequences. What to do:

- Create a number line from 1 to 20 using numbers or objects.
- Identify numbers before, after, or between specific numbers. Example:

- Number line: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, ...
- What number comes after 3? Answer: 4
- What number is between 2 and 4? Answer: 3

3. Pattern Block Art

Objective: Recognize and create patterns.

What to do:

- Use blocks or shapes to create a pattern (e.g., ABAB).
- Draw the pattern and describe it in 1-2 sentences. Example:
 - Pattern: red block, blue block, red block, blue block
 - Description: I made a pattern with alternating red and blue blocks.

4. Measurement Madness

Objective: Introduce basic measurement



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concepts. What to do:

- Measure the length of a book/table using non-standard units (e.g., pencils, blocks).
- click the picture of it and paste it in your scrap book by giving proper

measurements. Example:

- Book length: 5 crayons long
- click the picture of 5 crayons lined up next to the book with it.





1. Nature Diary

Objective: Encourage observation, reflection, and expression. What to do:

- Maintain a "Nature Diary" for 10 days.
- Each day, observe something in nature – a tree, flower, insect, bird, cloud.
- Draw it and write 2–3 lines about what you saw.

Example: "I saw a butterfly with yellow wings sitting on a red flower."

2. Waste to Wonder

Objective: Promote sustainability and creativity.

What to do:

- Use old/waste materials to create something useful or decorative.
- Click a picture with your creation.
- Give it a name and describe its use in 1–2 lines.

3. Little Eco-Warrior

Objective: Build responsibility towards the environment. What to do:

- Perform any 5 eco-friendly acts at home:
 - Watering plants
 - Switching off lights
 - Using a cloth bag
 - Avoiding plastic
- Draw or paste a photo of one act you enjoyed most.

4. My Favourite Food Plant – Poster

Making Objective: Learn about food sources and plant parts. What to do:

- Make a colorful poster on your favorite fruit or vegetable. Include:
 - Name of the plant
 - Part, we eat (root, stem, leaf, fruit, etc.)
 - Its health benefits
 - Pictures, drawings, or magazine cutouts
