Decorate your homework folder or file. Stickers, doodles, or borders — let your personality shine!






### Task 2 锅 Weather Craft – "My Weather Wheel"

### Task 3 Say & Learn: Weather Words



- . Cloudy The sky is full of clouds, and the sun is hiding behind them.




